**ARENA EVENTING:** jump a short course of show jumps then into adjoining ring to jump portable xc / working hunter fences and then back into show jump ring to finish course. There will be an optimum time; places decided on jumping faults – if there is equality of faults then time will be taken into consideration – the closest to the optimum time being placed highest (quicker taking precedence over slower). Jumping faults will be as for show jumping over the whole course. Refusals / disobediences – elimination on third, counted separately in show-jumping and cross-country courses.

## SCHEDULE:

- CLASS ONE:** 60cm Show jumping -- Individuals and Mercian Teams  
**CLASS TWO:** 70cm Show jumping – Individuals and Mercian Teams  
**CLASS THREE:** 70cm Arena Eventing-- Individuals  
**CLASS FOUR:** 80cm Show jumping – Individuals only  
**CLASS FIVE:** 80cm Arena Eventing – Individuals only  
**CLASS SIX:** 85cm Show jumping – Individuals only  
**CLASS SEVEN:** 85cm Arena Eventing -- Individuals only

## HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY FOR THIS EVENT

1. The Organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.
2. The event is organised in accordance with health and safety legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that:
  - a) everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health & safety and welfare of those attending the event.
  - b) those attending the event conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk
  - c) access to and egress from the site is safe
3. Emergencies-emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. First Aid points are clearly marked.

In case of emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 on the nearest telephone.
4. Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.
5. Dogs **MUST** be on a lead and under close control at **ALL** times.
6. All competitors must ensure that they have adequate/appropriate insurance for themselves, horses, property and third party.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Judges decision is final
2. Legal Liability: neither the Organisers nor any persons acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or illness to ponies/horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the schedule.
4. Any objections or protests must be handed into the Show Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld)
5. Hard hats to the standard acceptable to British Riding Clubs (see their website) must be worn and correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted.
6. Show jumping will be judged under BRC / BS Rules 2017.

Arena Eventing will be run under BRC / BS 2017 rules
7. The Committee reserve the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground.
