Entries fee cheques for any show cancelled due to bad weather will be destroyed, not carried forward to another show.

Points will be awarded throughout the series towards the Championship. The winner of the previous championship (Horse /Rider combination) will not be awarded any points in the current championship.

October –February shows will be held indoors. An outdoor arena may also be run in March.
