SHOW JUMPING:

Classes One to Four are for Mercian Teams and Open Individuals; all team members will also be judged as Individuals with any Open entries. Class Five is for Individuals only.

All classes will be run single phase.

All class heights are maximum for the first section; the second section (against the clock) may be up to 5cm higher.

Class One: 60cm

Class Two: 70cm

Class Three: 80cm

Class Four: 90cm

Class Five: 1m

Entry Fee: Open Entries (includes Mercian Team entries) : £12 per combination per class
CEVRC Members: £10 per combination per class

All Show jumping classes are Qualifiers for:

P.C. Area 9 Show jumping Championships (Rectory Farm on 1st September 2019 for PC Members in Area 9 only)

*and
Championships of Great Britain (at Cricklands: Juniors (16 & under) 16th – 18th August
and Seniors (any age) 9th – 11th August.)*

If you jump clear in any show jumping class, collect your qualifying card from the Secretary, once you have completed all your SJ classes.

DRESSAGE:

Class Six: BD Intro B (2009)

Class Seven: BD Prelim 12 (2005)

Class Eight: BD Novice 24 (2010)

Entry Fee: Open Entries: £12 per combination per Test
CEVRC Members: £10 per combination per Test

COMBINED TRAINING:

Depending on which test and what height, you may have to show jump before your dressage test.

There will be time slots for each show jumping height and you will be given your dressage time – so put your number down at the show jumping during the time slot for your entered height. CT entries will be also be judged individually (and/or as part of a Mercian Team) for their show jumping class.

Class Nine: BD Intro B (2009) + one show jumping class

Class Ten: BD Prelim 12 (2005) + one show jumping class

Class Eleven: BD Novice 24 (2010) + one show jumping height

N.B. You must state which show jumping height you are doing when you enter; if you miss the allocated time slot then you can jump the next height.

Entry Fee: Open Entries: £20

CEVRC members: £18 per combination per class.

Mercian Team Members: £8 in addition to their SJ entry fee. (If entering on your own entry form please state that you are also part of a Mercian team and which one)

Rosettes: Show jumping to sixth place for teams and individuals
Dressage & Combined Training to sixth place.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY FOR THIS EVENT

1. The Organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.
2. The event is organised in accordance with Health and Safety legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that:
 - a) everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the Health & Safety and welfare of those attending the event.
 - b) those attending the event conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk
 - c) access to and egress from the site is safe
3. Emergencies-emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. First Aid points are clearly marked.

In case of emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 on the nearest telephone.
4. Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.
5. Dogs **MUST** be on a lead and under close control at **ALL** times.
6. All competitors must ensure that they have adequate/appropriate insurance for themselves, horses, property and third party.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Judges decision is final
2. Legal Liability: neither the Organisers nor any persons acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or illness to ponies/horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the schedule.
4. Any objections or protests must be handed into the Show Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld)
5. Hard hats to the standard acceptable to British Riding Clubs (see their website) must be worn and correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted.
6. Show jumping will be judged under BRC / BS Rules 2019.

Dressage will be run under BD 2019 rules
7. The Committee reserve the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground.

10. Mercian teams – teams of three or four with best three to count.
