

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The committee reserve the right to cancel, amend or alter the order of events.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry or disqualify any animal that is deemed unfit to compete.
3. The committee and landowners will not be responsible for any injuries arising from accidents to persons or animals, or theft of properties on the grounds during the event.
4. The Judges and the Committee's decision shall be final on all matters during the event.
5. Any objections are to be handed to the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20 to be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
6. This showground is kindly lent to us; the show is run entirely by volunteers. Anyone using unreasonable behaviour, bad language, dropping litter, mucking out on the showground, mistreating any animal or anything else that affect the Club's reputation, will be asked to leave the showground.
7. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON.** Please bear this in mind when entering.
8. Hard hats are compulsory at all times when mounted and MUST comply with the current BRC guidelines.
9. All horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old to compete in ridden classes. In-hand classes are open to Youngstock.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times; failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the showground. Please clear up after your dog.
11. All showing classes will be run under current BSPS rules.
12. Strictly no cantering / galloping on the showground, except in the practice rings provided.
13. The road outside the showground is very busy. It is the responsibility of everyone to ensure the gates remain closed after entering or leaving the showground.
14. MHRC members MUST present a valid membership card to the secretary to take advantage of the class fee discounts.
15. Stallions are eligible to compete at this show, but all BRC rules apply and stallion discs must be worn on both sides of the bridle.
16. All riders must have reached their 4th birthday on the day of the show.

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or for anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Riding Club, nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their content and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The Organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards. Additionally, those attending this event must report incidents or accidents to the Secretary involving Property or Vehicle Damage, Personal Injury or Personal Illness.

(Must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Show to include a jump; there will be a choice of 4 at different heights for all Levels)
- M3** Coloured Horse or Pony
(Can be shown plaited or un-plaited depending on type. Open to Palomino, Dun, Piebald, Skewbald and Spotted)
- M4** Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony
(16 years and over - age must be displayed on bridle)
