- Late entries may be accepted if classes have space (but should not be relied upon).
- Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and will not be carried forward.

Points will be awarded throughout the series towards the Championship. The winner of the previous championship (Horse /Rider combination) will not be awarded any points in the current championship. Only points for 2 tests per fixture will be counted.

October – February shows will be held indoors. An outdoor arena may also be run in March.
